Each year, upon holding a troop or team election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the unit committee may nominate registered unit adults (age 21 or over) to the lodge adult selection committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the unit committee may nominate the current unit leader (but not assistant leaders), providing he or she has served as unit leader for at least the previous 12 months.

1. Selection of the adult is based upon ability to perform the necessary functions and not for recognition of service, including current or prior achievement and position. The individual's abilities include:
